

## The 1,2,3's of Labeling Blood Specimens (Non-PPID facilities or Downtime)



## **Label Preparation**

- Specimens collected *must* be labeled at the patient • bedside
- Write and verify the collection information on the patient label (Time/Date of Collection and Cerner ID)

Note: <u>Do Not</u> Write on or Near the BARCODE



## Label Placement

- Place the label lengthwise •
  - Patient name by cap reading label from left to right
- Label should cover manufacturer label on tube
- Leave window to view blood volume

## INCORRECT

Twisted labels, and labels placed too low on tubes can't be read by the analyzer and will delay samples
