## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

## **Barcode Blood Band - Condensed**



**VERIFY** the patient identity

WRITE any desired information (date of specimen collection, phlebotomist's initials, etc.) per your facility SEAL the edges down on a flat surface using your protocol to the left of the blood bank ID (BBID) using a ballpoint pen



**PROTECT** this information by removing the shield liner and pressing the shield down fingers



WRAP band tail around patient extremity to size SNAP button closure to secure CUT excess band tail material with scissors



DRAW pre-transfusion specimen per your protocol **PEEL** one BBID sticker from the band

APPLY BBID sticker to specimen tube so that "TOP" is at the top of the tube and the barcode runs along the length of the tube

**APPLY** the appropriate patient label to the specimen tube per your protocol; be sure it does not cover the barcode on the BBID sticker



**REMOVE** the additional sticker from the band at the perforation

ATTACH the additional sticker to the specimen tube (if desired) by peeling the adhesive tab on the underside of the removed portion

TRANSPORT to blood bank



SCAN BBID into the Laboratory Information System, or enter it manually



PEEL the adhesive tab on the underside of the two smaller BBID stickers



SECURE these stickers to the band for future use
