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The 1, 2, 3's of Labeling Blood Specimens with PPID

Label Preparation



- Specimens collected *must* be labeled at the patient bedside
- Scan barcode on labeled specimen, once signed the collection information will be captured electronically.
 - o Time of Collection
 - o Date of Collection
 - Cerner ID

Note: **Do Not** Write On label

Label Placement 2



- Place the label lengthwise
 - o Patient name by cap reading label from left to right
- Label should cover manufacturer label on tube
- Leave window to view blood volume

INCORRECT



Twisted labels, and labels placed too low on the tube cannot be read by the instrument



Properly labeled tubes result in faster TAT
